Conflict Materials Verification

With reference to your request concerning the recent legislation and the use of conflict minerals, in the sense of the Wall Street reform and consumer act and/or Dodd Frank Act, we are able to confirm the following;

No materials supplied derive from or include such raw materials as Columbite-tantalite (Coltan), Cassiterite, Wolframite (from which Tin, Tungsten and Tantalum commonly derive) and Gold that were mined in conditions of armed conflict and human rights abuses.

We do not knowingly provide materials made by using Conflict Minerals from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and its surrounding countries – Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, Congo Republic, Rwanda, Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda and Zambia.

Our supply chain are requested to declare to us the origin of all materials used in supply to us, and all purchase orders have the following disclaimer;
